Fellowship in Faith for Families

Fellowship in Faith offers Christian formation for children and youth on Sunday mornings, September-May, between the 9:15 and 11:15 services. Lessons draw from the Bible, Christian tradition, and the natural world to deepen children's spiritual lives, and develop their expressions of faith. This fall's theme is the family

of God. Children will consider what it means to be a child of God and learn classic Bible stories from the Bible's best known families.

While children's classes meet, adults are invited to the Dean's Forum (below), where clergy and guest speakers lead discussions on a variety of spiritual topics.
